Key Principles:

Our Educational Offer during this period has been shaped with the following key principles in mind:

Personalisation

We have provided a bespoke learning package to meet the individual need of all students, covering curriculum areas that they would access within college. These have been planned and implemented by teaching staff who have taken into consideration the following aspects.

- Their home-learning environment and capacity of parents/carers availability of resources such as electronic equipment, stationary and craft supplies, availability of individual adult support.

Relationships:

Maintaining contact and good relationships is paramount in order to support the young person and family at this time. It will also ensure a smoother transition back into college post COVID. Staff are assigned to make contact with students through phone calls, emails, posted packages. Some staff are now providing Zoom sessions to students to help them with set work. Senior Leaders are responsible for ensuring that teachers set and monitor the work set. All contact with home is recorded within an 'daily communication log' spreadsheet document that all the tutors have access to as Netscaler is now in place for all the team.

Our Offer Education:

Each young person has a bespoke package of home learning which includes features from below:

- Access to tutors and SLT when required. Regular contact from Tutors and LSWs by email and phone calls. Additional telephone communication from Learning Support Workers for some individuals.
- Suggested weekly and daily routine provided to students via letter from Head of College
- Work packages have been sent by post
- Daily uploads through online learning platform Seneca and Kerboddle
- Recommendation of websites and other online learning platforms have been given to students
- ❖ Teaching staff are using Seneca Learning Platform, googleclassroom and Zoom to conduct, track and set work for students.
- Educational Pastoral Lead and LSWs are in regular contact with students checking on their welfare. LSWs have been assigned specific students to make regular contact. Evidence of contact is also being put in their student files by the LSWs.
- Googleclassroom is being used as an interactive source to support.
- All tutors are signed up RNIB book share which enables students to: listen to books with high quality text-to-speech voices, hear and see highlighted words on screen, read with digital braille or enlarged fonts, create physical braille or large print, ready directly from your internet browser and more!


Residential Support/Input:


- The Residential Teams are all in regular contact with their students either via email, phone and some staff have set up online gaming sessions.

- Support staff are in daily contact with all day and residential students


Therapy Support:


 The Therapy Team are holding weekly sessions with their students via Zoom or Skype.


