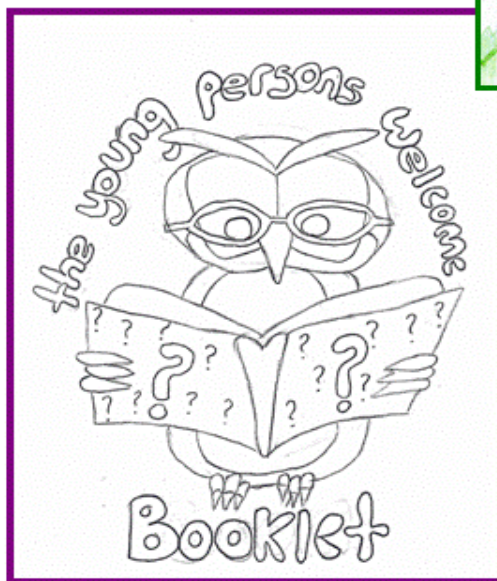

They are all there to help you

Ask your foster carer for the numbers and to let you use the phone or e-mail

Your social worker will be working with all the adults to make sure you have a care plan

Everyone will be working hard to keep you safe

If you do not understand, ask your social worker



Independent Advocate

An Independent Advocate is a person who will help you in any way he or she can. They do not work for the Local Authority or Priority Fostering and that is what we mean when we say they are independent. If you want to find one you can call the number below and they will help you.
