Located in the rural village of Ashover in Derbyshire, Eastwood Grange School is set within 14 acres of beautiful grounds. We provide specialist education and care services for young people aged 5 to 18 years with social, emotional and mental health (SEMH) needs, and behaviours that challenge.

We pride ourselves on delivering highly individualised support packages for each of our students, designed to develop their education, social and independence skills.

Our aims

All young people have an entitlement to a positive educational experience and to succeed. We aim to provide an environment in which the students are encouraged to learn through positivity and appropriate learning, meeting a diversity of needs. We provide a success-based curriculum delivered by experienced staff who are skilled in supporting young people with behavioural, emotional and social development needs.

Our aims include:

- **Helping young people to understand the issues they face and implement ways of addressing them, with a particular focus delivered through a therapeutic approach**
- **Assisting young people to learn how to manage their anxieties and behaviour, with self-discipline and clearly established boundaries**
- **Developing independence skills within a safe, secure and structured environment**
- **Empowering young people to make positive decisions and choices, leading to a brighter future**

The teaching methods at Eastwood Grange School vary depending upon the group and the individuals within it. Our curriculum includes literacy and numeracy, as well as vocational studies, including construction, life skills, careers guidance, work experience and college link courses.

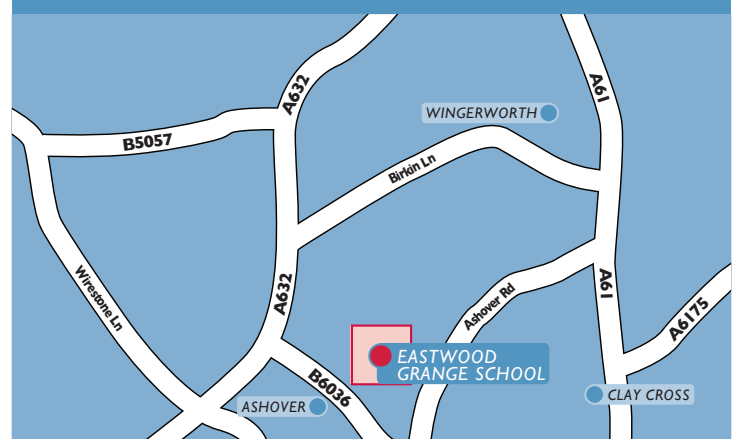
Admissions criteria
