Through providing a pupil-centred, non-judgemental, non-punitive, caring and supportive education that is integrated into our overall care provision, we are able to focus on educational progress and positive change.

Care and accommodation is provided within one of the children's homes in the surrounding area. All of the homes provide safe, secure and homely living from small two-bedded units to larger six-bedded units, each with single bedrooms and en-suite facilities. All houses have TV lounge, kitchen and dining areas and pupils are encouraged to participate in the daily running of the house to make it a pleasant environment in which to live.

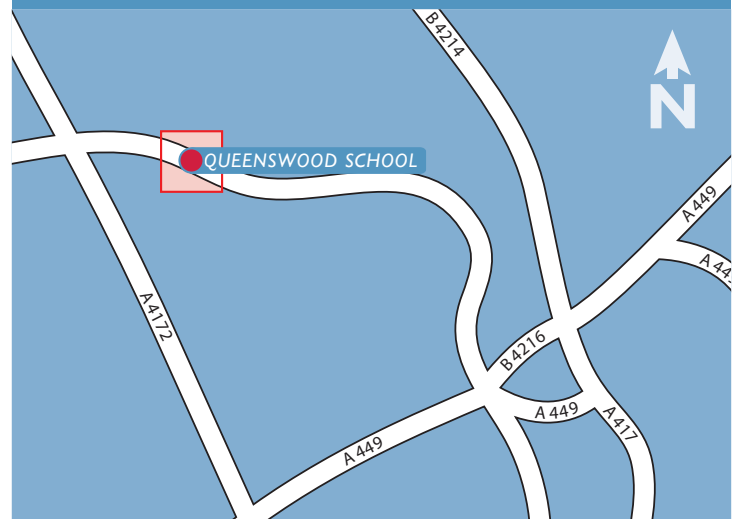
