

Sketchley School

Sketchley School is a specialist day school for young people aged 8 to 19 years with Asperger Syndrome, autistic spectrum disorders and associated conditions. Pupils may also have challenging behaviour as a result of their communication difficulties and a lack of social understanding.

Set within an acre of mature grounds in the heart of Sketchley, the school provides pupils with a safe, specially adapted environment in which to learn and grow. The school is specifically designed for pupils with autism and includes rooms for specialist subjects, therapy and quiet areas.

Services offered

- **Academic curriculum in line with mainstream provision including GCSE options**
- **Intensive therapeutic programmes and strategies designed to assist with anxiety**
- **Strong links with local employers to provide an extensive work experience programme for pupils**
- **Opportunities to integrate into community life**

Admissions criteria

- **Aged between 8 and 19 years**
- **A diagnosis of autistic spectrum disorder or evidence of behaviours which are in accordance with such a diagnosis**
- **Associated complex needs**
- **An education, health and care plan**

- Music therapy




Positive outcomes
